Dear Parents and Community Members:

We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER) which provides key information on the 2022-2023 educational progress for the Adrian Community High School formerly known as Adrian Adult and Alternative. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. If you have any questions about the AER, please contact Assistant Superintendent, Derrick Richards or Lead Teacher, Adrienne Phelps for assistance.

For the 2022-23 school year, schools were identified using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that has at least one underperforming student subgroup. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that has three or more underperforming student subgroups. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance is in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state or has a graduation rate at or below 67%. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

Our school HAS NOT BEEN GIVEN ONE OF THESE LABELS.

School Background

Adrian Community High School is an Alternative High School supporting students whom has previously experienced academic struggles in a regular setting, many of which at enrollment are not on track to graduate. However, Adrian Community High School gives these students an opportunity to stay in school and follow a path towards graduation, even if it exceeds the normal four year process. Students may also continue their education in the Adult Education Program if not completed by time they are 20 years of age. To help provide support to these students, all student who are academically needing support are provided a Graduation Coach and one on one tutoring.

Process for Assigning Pupils to the School, Adrian Public Schools

Adrian Public School students are assigned to schools using the attendance boundaries that have been established by the district. In district students must apply through Adrian High School for enrollment. Adrian Community High School also participate in School of Choice. Parents requesting Schools of Choice must submit paperwork to our Adrian Board of Education.

This same process used in the prior 2021-2022 school year.

The Status of the 3-5 School Improvement Plan

Adrian Community High School is in its sixth year of the school improvement plan. Improvement goals include, but not limited to, increasing student achievement across all core subjects, with emphasis on English and mathematics, increase graduation rate, increase parental involvement, and increase student attendance in relationship with teacher mentor communication.

Adrian Community High School has graduation coaches, a social worker and extended individualized learning opportunities with teachers of core subject areas to help increase student achievement, number of courses completed and graduation rate.

Specialized Schools Annual Report

2022-2023 Specialized Schools Report

The students of (Name of School District) receive special education services through the Lenawee Intermediate School District (LISD). In addition to the specialized schools, students receive diagnostic testing, school psychology, school social work, physical and occupational therapy, career technical education, special needs training, and speech pathology services.

The Lenawee Intermediate School District provides educational services to students from birth through age 26 who have severe handicaps. Students with severe physical, mental, emotional, or sensory impairments may receive their educational program in a classroom operated by the LISD. Less than 10 students from Adrian Public Schools attended LISD classroom programs during the 2022-23 school year.

The LISD operates the Laura Haviland Program for early elementary, elementary, middle, and high school students with severe emotional and behavioral impairments. 10 students from Adrian Public Schools attended Laura Haviland during the 2022-23 school year.

In cooperation with the Lenawee County Probate Court, the LISD operates the juvenile education program housed at the Maurice Spear Campus.

LISD operates special education classrooms in local districts including classrooms for students with physical or other health impairments and hearing impairments in Madison, and classrooms for students with cognitive impairments in Tecumseh and Adrian. 13 students from Adrian Public Schools attended these programs during the 2022-23 school year.

The LISD PREP Academy provides educational programs for teen parents from Lenawee County. During the student's instructional program, childcare support is provided. Less than 10 students from Adrian Public Schools attended the LISD PREP Academy during the 2022-23 school year.

The LISD TECH Center offers career technical education programs for high school juniors and seniors.151 students from Adrian Public Schools attended the LISD TECH Center or participated in the co-op/work experience program during 2022-23. This equals 43% of the junior and senior population for this school district.

The most recent follow-up of LISD TECH Center students (a 2023 study of 2022 graduates) showed 56.6% were continuing their education. Of those continuing their education, 76.7% were continuing in a field related to their LISD TECH Center program. In addition, 91.4% were working (full-time or part-time) with 5.0% reporting they were unemployed/seeking employment. Of those working full-time, 75.4% were in a field related to their LISD TECH Center program.

2021-2022 Specialized Schools Report

The students of (Adrian Public Schools) receive special education services through the Lenawee Intermediate School District (LISD). In addition to the specialized schools, students receive diagnostic testing, school psychology, school social work, physical and occupational therapy, career technical education, special needs training and speech pathology services.

The Lenawee Intermediate School District provides educational services to students from birth through age 26 who have severe handicaps. Students with severe physical, mental, emotional or sensory impairments may receive their educational program at a classroom operated by the LISD. Students from (Adrian Public Schools) attended LISD classroom programs during the 2021-22 school year.

for students with cognitive impairments in Tecumseh and Adrian. Thirteen students from (Adrian Public Schools) attended these programs during the 2021-22 school year.

The LISD PREP Academy provides educational programs for teen parents from Lenawee County. During the student's instructional program, childcare support is provided. Less than ten students from (Adrian Public Schools) attended the LISD PREP Academy during the 2021-22 school year.

The LISD TECH Center offers career technical education programs for high school juniors and seniors. 373 students from (Adrian Public Schools) attended the LISD TECH Center or participated in the co-op/work experience program during 2021-22. This equals 35.1% of the junior and senior population for this school district.

The most recent follow-up of LISD TECH Center students (a 2022 study of 2021 graduates) showed 50.5% were continuing their education. Of those continuing their education, 89.8% were continuing in a field related to their LISD TECH Center program. In addition, 85.7% were working (full-time or part-time) with 5.8% reporting they were unemployed/seeking employment. Of those working full-time, 67.4% were in a field related to their LISD TECH Center program.

Local districts operate special education classrooms open to students from other districts. There are two MiCI classrooms in the county that other districts can send students to. One is the LISD MiCI HS classroom at BD and the other is the MS and HS MiCI classrooms at Addison. Beyond that districts do individual agreements to allow students to attend a classroom in another district
