Dear Parents and Community Members:

We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER) which provides key information on the 2017-18 educational progress for Springbrook Middle School. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. For the 2017-18 school year, schools were identified using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that has at least one underperforming student subgroup. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that has three or more underperforming student subgroups. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance is in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state or has a graduation rate at or below 67%. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

Springbrook Middle School was identified as a targeted support and improvement school based on test scores for our special education sub group.

## School Background

State law requires that we also report additional information. All 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade students in the Adrian City School District who are assigned to Springbrook Middle School. We are currently in the fourth year of our school improvement plan and are making modifications, as necessary, as we assess current data available to the school. Our goal is to increase student achievement in all subject areas and to continue to challenge our students, so that they may realize their fullest potential.

## Core Curriculum

The school follows the core curriculum complete with its strands, benchmarks, and grade level content expectations (GLCEs) in the areas of science, social studies, physical education and health. In English and math, we are transitioning to the National Common Core Standards. This curriculum can be accessed through the Michigan Department of Education's website, <u>www.michigan.gov/mde</u>. ## 2018-19 Specialized Schools Annual Report

The students of Adrian Public Schools receive special education services through the Lenawee Intermediate School District (LISD). In addition to the specialized schools, students receive diagnostic testing, school psychology, school social work, physical and occupational therapy, career technical education, special needs training and speech pathology services.

The Lenawee Intermediate School District provides educational services to students from birth through age 26 who have severe handicaps. Students with severe physical, mental, emotional or sensory impairments may receive their educational program at a classroom operated by the LISD. Zero students from Adrian Public Schools attended LISD classroom programs during the 2017-18 school year.

The LISD operates the Laura Haviland Program for elementary, middle and high school students with severe emotional and behavioral impairments. 11 students from Adrian Public Schools attended Laura Haviland during the 2017-18 school year.

In cooperation with the Lenawee County Probate Court, the LISD operates the juvenile education program housed at the Maurice Spear Campus.

LISD operates special education classrooms in local districts including classrooms for students with physical or other health impairments and hearing impairments in Madison; and classrooms for students with cognitive impairments in Tecumseh and Adrian. 23 students from Adrian Public Schools attended these programs during the 2017-18 school year.

The LISD PREP Academy provides educational programs for teen parents from Lenawee County. During the student's instructional program, childcare support is provided. 7 students from Adrian Public Schools attended the LISD PREP Academy during the 2017-18 school year.

The LISD TECH Center offers career technical education programs for high school juniors and seniors. 176 students from Adrian Public Schools attended the LISD TECH Center or participated in the co-op/work experience program during 2017-18. This equals 34% of the junior and senior population for this school district.

The most recent follow-up of LISD TECH Center students (a 2017 study of 2016 graduates) showed 67.5% were continuing their education. Of those continuing their education, 86.0% were continuing in a field related to their LISD TECH Center program. In addition, 98.6% were working (full-time or part-time) with 1.7% reporting they were unemployed/seeking employment. Of those working full-time, 72.7% were in a field related to their LISD TECH Center program.

LISD operates special education classrooms in local districts including classrooms for students with physical or other health impairments and hearing impairments in Madison, and classrooms for students with cognitive impairments in Tecumseh and Adrian. Seventeen students from Adrian Public Schools attended these programs during the 2017-18 school year.

The LISD PREP Academy provides educational programs for teen parents from Lenawee County. During the student's instructional program, childcare support is provided. Fourteen students from Adrian Public Schools attended the LISD PREP Academy during the 2017-18 school year.

The LISD TECH Center offers career technical education programs for high school juniors and seniors. 504 students from Adrian Public Schools attended the LISD TECH Center or participated in the co-op/work experience program during 2017-18. This equals 33 % of the junior and senior population for this school district.

The most recent follow-up of LISD TECH Center students (a 2017 study of 2016 graduates) showed 67.5% were continuing their education. Of those continuing their education, 86.0% were continuing in a field related to their LISD TECH Center program. In addition, 98.6% were working (full-time or part-time) with 1.7% reporting they were unemployed/seeking employment. Of those working full-time, 72.7% were in a field related to their LISD TECH Center program.

Students with Mild Cognitive Impairments are serviced by Springbrook Middle School staff in the MICI classroom. The MICI classroom serves students of Adrian Public Schools in grades 6, 7 and 8. The LISD services students with Moderate Cognitive Impairments (MOCI,) at Springbrook Middle School, who are of middle school age.

## Student Achievement Results for Nationally Normed Achievement Tests

All students also participate in the M-step test in the spring of the year. The M-step test assesses students based on State of Michigan Grade Level Standards in math, science and English. All students also completed MAP testing through the Northwest Evaluation Association (NWEA.) This test is used to assess students' basic skills and monitor their progress in comparison to other students at their grade level. They are also used in determining the best placement for students in classes.

## Aggregate results from M-step testing are attached below.

Currently we are in our fourth year of administration of the M-step test. We are using the results from this test to inform decisions about our instruction and curriculum, with the goal of continuing to increase the number of students who score proficient in each subject area.

During Parent Teacher Conferences, 52% of students were represented. This is a slight increase from our percentage of 47% the year before.
