ARTICLE XXIV - INSURANCE PROTECTION

2. Medical Coverage

Plan A Medical Coverage:

Upon proper application and acceptance for enrollment by the appropriate underwriter, policyholder, and/or third-party administrator, the District shall make health insurance premium payments, beginning May 1, 2018, July 1, 2019 up to \$528.72-549.55 a month for single coverage on the Head Start and Food Service employee's behalf. The Board will pay for eligible K-12 employees 60% of the premium for single subscriber health coverage.
