## The Chormann Family Scholarship

#### History

Richard and Carolyn Chormann are both Adrian High School graduates and Western Michigan University alumni. This scholarship was established in their honor. Since its inception in 1999, The Chormann Family Scholarship has been awarded to 21 AHS seniors, with total scholarships awarded over \$600,000. All scholarship recipients will have graduated from AHS with a minimum GPA of 3.0 and must attend Western Michigan University for the duration of the scholarship.

#### **Details of Scholarship**

The Chormann Family Scholarship, once awarded, will provide up to \$7,500 per year and is renewable for up to four academic years, totaling up to \$30,000. Scholarship recipients are expected to maintain a minimum GPA of 3.0 while attending Western Michigan University.

#### **Eligibility**

To be considered for the Chormann Family Scholarship, all applicants:

- Must have a minimum GPA of 3.0
- Must be accepted to Western Michigan University

#### **Application Procedures**

Applications for The Chormann Family Scholarship are available beginning November 1, 2021 through <u>adrianmaples.org</u> website for eligible seniors who intend to apply to Western Michigan University before January 1, 2022.

Scholarship applicants must:

- Complete the Adrian High School Scholarship Application (including all attachments listed on the application).
- Submit materials by December 1, 2021
